

Have you joined the 2016-2017 PHS Pirate Boosters yet? If not, it is not too late!

Joining Boosters is easy. Simply visit our website http://www.phspirateboosters.com and click on "Membership" tab on the home screen. Once there, scroll down to fill out the membership form online and pay with your credit card or PayPal account. You may also print out a registration form and return it to Palatine High School with a check. Another option is to visit the Booster Booth at varsity home football games to purchase your membership. Rain or shine, membership representatives are there to answer your questions. We've made some changes this year... This year's PHS Booster Club membership offerings differ from vears past. Our Basic Membership now starts at \$25. Basic Membership includes a car decal, a coupon good for a one-time 20% discount at the Pirate Treasures School Store on a purchase of \$30 or more, and our online newsletters throughout the year that will keep you informed of our many activities and volunteer opportunities. New this year is the Family Membership for \$60. Family Membership includes everything in the Basic Membership, PLUS two adult athletic passes and two child (8TH Grade and Under) athletic passes. We continue to offer adult, child, and grandparent athletic passes for purchase in an ala carte format**. Athletic passes are valid for entry into all home football games (excluding IHSA playoffs) and girls' and boys' basketball games. Passes purchased through Boosters offer members the convenience of simply showing their pass at the gate and a substantial savings over buying individual game

tickets. These changes have been made in an effort for pricing consistency across all District 211 booster clubs.

**Please note that only one basic membership is required to purchase any amount of athletic passes and current District 211 Students do not need a pass because they are admitted free to athletic events with a valid ID.
