Hello, Pirate Families!

It is hard to believe that we are in the final stretch of the school year! The Palatine Boosters continue to support the entire school community to finish the year stronger than we started.

We are so glad many of you enjoyed our 38th Annual Dinner & Auction on March 3rd, at The Cotillion. Thank you to everyone who came out, supported this event, and volunteered to help. We want to give a HUGE thank you to our dedicated committee chairs, Cynthia Coroneos, Laurie DeSimone, and Monica Haun, for all of the time and energy they put in to make this event successful. We raised approximately \$53,000 which will go directly back to the PHS students.

One way Boosters gives back to the PHS school community is through mini grants. We are pleased to share that all of our fundraising efforts over the past year allow us to give \$55,000 back to the PHS administration to be used for mini grants. These funds will be dispersed to PHS staff and departments through an application process determined by administration. 


The School Spiritwear store will continue to be open during Thursday lunch hours from 10:30-1:30 pm on the following days:
